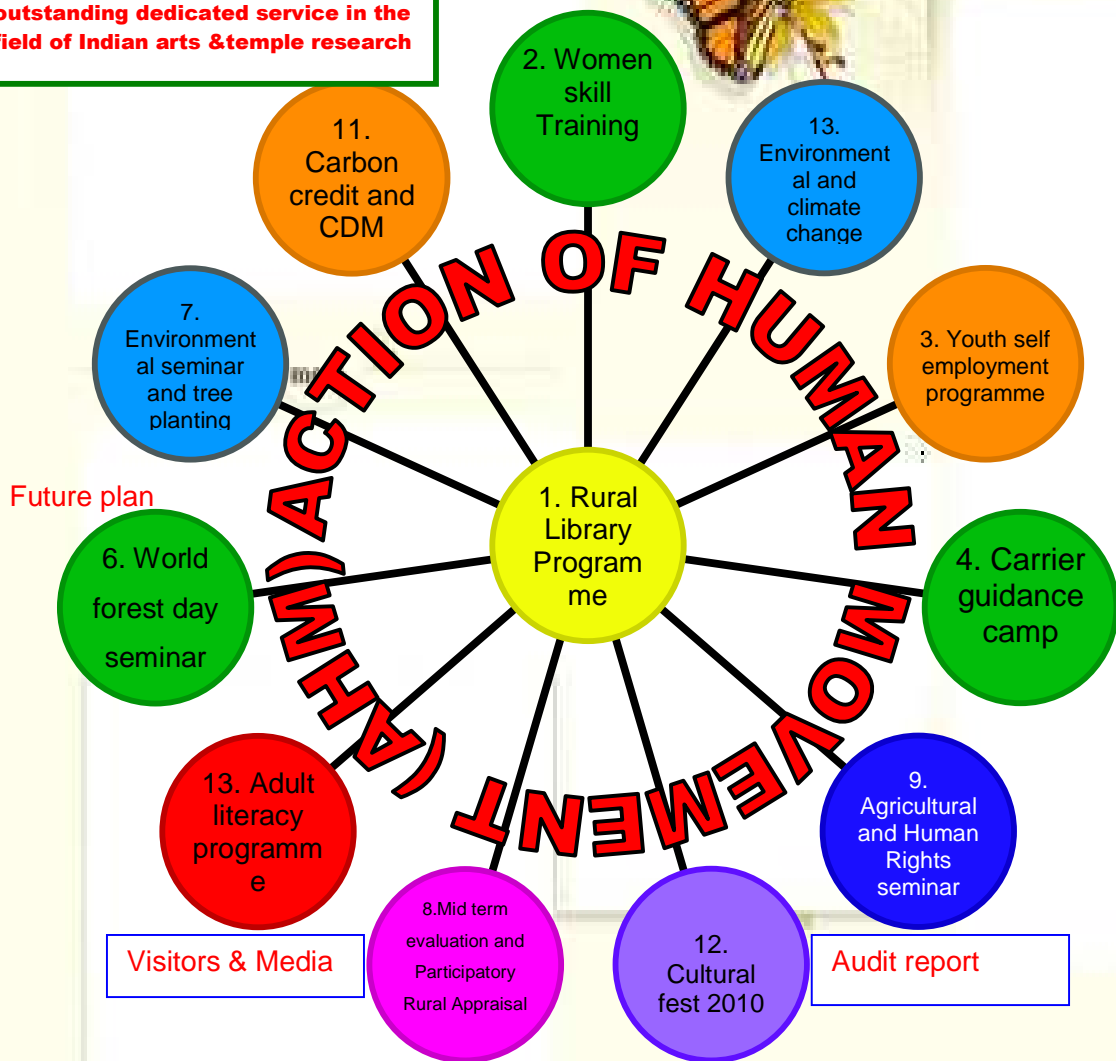

CARBON CREDIT AND CDM SEMINAR

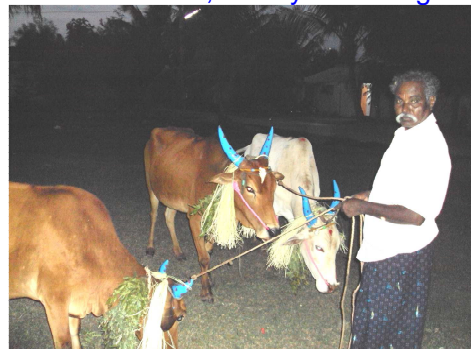
